Motion: Commissioner Prizzia stated that she would like to discuss community centers in a broad conversation as several of them are struggling in the current economy rather than just discussing the need in High Springs. She would like to discuss this at a Policy Meeting.

County Manager Lieberman stated that a Comprehensive discussion of Community Centers will be scheduled for March with the appropriate staff.


