Hawthorne Area Resource Center serves the east side of Alachua County along the US 301 corridor, which is essentially the City of Hawthorne and the 10 surrounding unincorporated communities. The region is in a food desert, persistently impoverished and underserved, and lacks economic opportunity and access. In 2022 HARC distributed over 300,000 pounds of food to patrons, which was an increase of over 30,000 pounds from 2021. Acquisition of a refrigerated truck will help Hawthorne Area Resource Center (HARC) meet the growing food insecurity needs of its patrons.

Currently, to adequately stock the pantry, HARC must rely on deliveries from partnering organizations like and Farm Share. If the delivery is small enough and is nearby, like Bread of the Mighty, occasionally volunteers are able to pick up food in their personal vehicles. However, this has proven to be inefficient for various reasons, and as a result we have been unable to fully meet the needs of the community. With the acquisition of a refrigerated truck, HARC would be able to get larger donations from food banks that are further away.
