Rebuilding Together North Central Florida (RTNCF) has provided critical, emergency, aging-in-place, and energy efficiency up and tune-up services in Alachua County for more than 18 years. These services have eliminated thousands of home hazards, maintained affordability in homeownership, incentivizing hundreds of our neighbors to remain in the homes, neighborhoods an communities where they've lived for years.	and	
The [Re]Build Repair Vehicle Fleet Project will increase the efficiencies of RTNCF's programs by expanding the capacity of prostaff in provision of on-site services, such as oversight of volunteer work days and subcontracted repairs. The proposed plan voluntees efficiencies in pick up and delivery of tools and materials to repair sites. This project is designed to optimize RTNCF's infrastructure to reduce current program bottlenecks and to strengthen programs to provide more home repairs to qualified applicably.	vill also	
Since a recent accident that rendered a company vehicle inoperable, RTNCF has managed all repair programs with a single designated program vehicle, a mini van. Program staff spend an estimated 10+ hours per week preparing for site work by pact tools and supplies for specific repairs. Due to the size of the van there is not sufficient room to pack for multiple days, or sever of repairs at once. Having only one program vehicle limits the organization's capacity to host multiple repair sites on the same	al types	
Despite this challenge, RTNCF has provided 20-30 critical and emergency repairs per year. Through this project, we anticipate significant savings in staff time, which will increase staff capacity to take on additional repair program related tasks and to increprogram outputs in two metricshazards corrected, and homes served.		
We estimate that through the efficiencies increased by this funding we can increase the number of hazards removed and the roof homes served by 10-20% in consecutive years. This translates to more than 1,000 hours per year in saved staff time, as we projected increase of program outputs including 18-35 additional hazards eliminated, and an additional 6-12 estimated neighborserved, living in 3-6 unique homes annually. We project that as we increase organizational capacity in other ways, that these fixestimates will continue to grow in following years.	ll as a ors
