

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTINUING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
ALACHUA COUNTY AND TWO-FOLD WATER ENGINEERING, INC., NO. 13716**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Continuing Services Agreement (“Amendment”) is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the “County”) and TWO-FOLD WATER ENGINEERING INC, a Florida for Profit Corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida (“Contractor”), who are collectively referred to as the “Parties”.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties previously entered into a Continuing Services Agreement for Annual Water Systems Monitoring and Inspection, dated February 24, 2023, identified by No. 13716 (the “Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the County has elected its option to renew the term of the original Agreement to allow the Contractor to furnish the goods or service to Alachua County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term and to do as otherwise provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. Amendment. Section #3, of the Agreement titled “Term” is amended to read as follows:

**3. Term.** This Agreement is effective upon execution by both Parties and continues until September 30, 2025, unless earlier terminated as provided herein. This Agreement may be amended at the option of the County for one additional two year term. The Contractor may choose not to renew this Agreement if the Contractor provides the County with written notice ninety (90) days prior to October 1 of the term renewal.

B. Amendment. Section #15.J, of the Agreement titled “E-Verify” is amended to read as follows:

**J. E-Verify.** Pursuant to F.S. sec. 448.095, Contractor shall register with and use the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all new employees of the Contractor during the term of the Agreement. Contractor shall require any subcontractors performing work or providing Services under this Agreement to register and use the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all new employees of the subcontractor during the term of this Agreement, and otherwise comply with Florida law. The E-Verify system is located at <https://www.uscis.gov/E-Verify>. Failure to comply with this section is grounds for termination and the Contractor (a) may not be awarded a contract with the

County for at least 1 year after the date on which the Agreement was terminated and (b) is liable for any additional costs incurred by the County as a result of termination of this Agreement.

C. Effective Date. Upon and after full execution of this Amendment by the Parties, this Amendment shall be effective on October 1, 2023.

D. Original Agreement. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
