FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 11516 BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND

GASTON TREE DEBRIS RECYCLING, LLC FOR ANNUAL WOOD WASTE PROCESSING BID 20-138

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 11516, made and entered into this day of September A.D. 20 21, by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "County", and Gaston Tree Debris Recycling, LLC, a Florida corporation with a principal address of 4190 NW 93rd Avenue Gainesville, FL 32653-7823, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor". Collectively, the County and the Contractor are hereinafter referred to as the "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in 2020, the County issued BID #20-138 seeking Contractors to furnish Annual Wood Waste Processing in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating and considering all timely responses to BID #20-138, the County identified the Contractor as the top ranked firm; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to BID #20-138 the Parties hereto previously entered into the Agreement for Contractual Services between Alachua County and Gaston Tree Debris Recycling, LLC, dated April 15, 2020 (the "Agreement") for the provision of Annual Wood Waste Processing; and

WHEREAS, the County has elected to exercise its first option to renew the Term of the Agreement for a two-year period commencing October 1, 2021 and continuing through September 30, 2023 ("First Renewal Option Term"), to increase the Not to Exceed Amount of the Agreement from \$35,000.00 to \$100,000.00 to cover expected increases work required by the County, to reflect the increase to the Alachua County Minimum Wage as mandated by the Alachua County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Article XII ("Wage Ordinance"), to add a Section number and re-number subsequent sections sequentially, to add a provision which defines and allows electronic signatures, and to add a provision which acknowledges the employment eligibility requirements via the U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Parties, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. PARAGRAPGH #1 of the Agreement, Term, is amended in its entirety to read:

The County has elected to exercise its first option to renew the Term of the Agreement. Accordingly, this amendment shall take effect on October 1, 2021 and continue through September 30, 2023 (the first renewal term) unless earlier terminated as provided herein.

The County has the option of renewing this Agreement for one (1) additional two (2) year period at the same terms and conditions outlined herein.

The County's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon a specific annual appropriation by the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners ("Board"). The Parties hereto understand that this Agreement is not a commitment of future appropriations. Therefore, the continuation of this Agreement beyond the end of any fiscal year shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes, and that the failure of the Board to do so shall not constitute a breach or default of this Agreement.

- B. A. PARAGRAPGH #4 of the Agreement, Method of Payment, sub-paragraph 4.1 is amended in its entirety to read:
 - 4.1 The Contractor shall be paid a sum not to exceed \$100,000.00 per fiscal year (October 1st through September 30th), allocated in the following manner:
- C. The Agreement inadvertently did not include a Section number for the section entitled ALACHUA COUNTY MINIMUM WAGE. That Section of the Agreement is hereby designated as Section 5 and is also hereby amended and replaced in its entirety to read as follows, and all subsequent sections of the Agreement are hereby renumbered sequentially with Section 5, entitled Duties of the County, to be renumbered as Section 6, Section 6 to be renumbered as Section 7, and so on:

5. ALACHUA COUNTY MINIMUM WAGE.

The Work performed through this Agreement is considered covered services under Chapter 22, Article III, of the Alachua County Code of Ordinances ("Wage Ordinance"), which establishes a government minimum wage for certain contractors/professionals and subcontractors providing selected services to Alachua County government. "Covered Employees," as defined in Sec. 22.12-101(a) of the Wage Ordinance, are those employees directly involved in providing covered services pursuant to this Agreement.

- 5.1 The current required Alachua County Government Minimum Wage is \$15.00 per hour when health Benefits are provided at the equivalent value of \$2.00 per hour and \$17.00 when health benefits are not provided (collectively, the "Minimum Wage").
- 5.2 The County may amend the applicable Minimum Wage on or before October 1st of each year.
- 5.3 The Contractor/Professional shall provide certification, the form of which is attached hereto as Attachment 7, VI the County that it pays each of its employees the Alachua County Government Minimum Wage, as may be amended by the County on or before October 1st of

each year, as well as ensuring that it will require the same of its subcontractors throughout the duration of this Agreement.

- 5.4 The Contractor/Professional shall prominently display a copy of the Wage Ordinance where it is easily seen by covered employees and supply to covered employees upon request. Additionally, the Contractor/Professional is responsible to make any person submitting a bid for a subcontract for covered services aware of the requirements.
- 5.5 Failure to comply with the provisions of the Wage Ordinance will be deemed a breach of contract and authorize the County to withhold payment of funds in accordance with Chapter 218, Florida Statutes.
- 5.6 The Contractor/Professional will include the necessary provisions in subcontracts to ensure compliance. However, the County shall not be deemed a necessary, or indispensable, party in any litigation between the contractor/professional and subcontractor.
- C. PARAGRAPGH 29, Electronic Signatures, is added to the Agreement as follows.

29. Electronic Signatures

The Parties agree that an electronic version of this Agreement shall have the same legal effect and enforceability as a paper version. The Parties further agree that this Agreement, regardless of whether in electronic or paper form, may be executed by use of electronic signatures. Electronic signatures shall have the same legal effect and enforceability as manually written signatures. The County shall determine the means and methods by which electronic signatures may be used to execute this Agreement and shall provide the Contractor with instructions on how to use said method. Delivery of this Agreement or any other document contemplated hereby bearing an manually written or electronic signature by facsimile transmission (whether directly from one facsimile device to another by means of a dial-up connection or whether mediated by the worldwide web), by electronic mail in "portable document format" (".pdf") form, or by any other electronic means intended to preserve the original graphic and pictorial appearance of a document, will have the same effect as physical delivery of the paper document bearing an original or electronic signature.

D. PARAGRAPH 30, U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System, is added as follows:

30. U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System

30.1 The Contractor/Professional shall utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the Contractor/Professional during the term of the Agreement. The E-Verify system is located at https://www.uscis.gov/e-verify

- 30.2 The Contractor/Professional shall expressly require any subcontractors performing work or providing services pursuant to the County's Agreement to utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the term of the Agreement. The E-Verify system is located at https://www.uscis.gov/e-verify.
- E. SAVE and EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect.
