Background:

The Board of County Commissioners directed the Equity Office to complete several tasks in response to the proposed Equity Plan presented on August 24, 2021. These tasks included:

- Assemble a 30-member Core Strategic Leadership team for equity across the organization and conduct an eight-month onboarding period.
- Create an Equity Advisory Committee and give priority to those with lived experience of

inequities.

- Define a community outreach management plan for the Board of County Commissioners.
- Provide the Board of County Commissioners with a formal social and racial equity onboarding workshop.

This report describes the progress made on these tasks and other activities, achievements, engagements, and plans of the Sustainability, Equity, and Economic Development Strategies (SEEDS) Equity Office.

Key Accomplishments

- The Core Strategic Leadership team was assembled and completed its eight-month onboarding period.
- The Equity Advisory Committee was created and is now working with staff to create implementation plans on equity in Alachua County.
- A community outreach management plan has been defined for the Board of County Commissioners.
- A formal social and racial equity onboarding workshop was provided to the Board of County Commissioners.
- Departmental goals related to equity have been created for the SEEDS and Growth Management departments.
- The SEEDS Equity Office has continued to build a three-legged stool approach to SEEDS projects, including local food, energy efficiency, solar, and the American Rescue Plan Act (AACRP).
- The Immigrant Liaison position has been onboarded, and the organizational foundation for the SEEDS GIS Analyst position has been laid.
- A detailed equity onboarding and biweekly meeting process has been developed and implemented.
- Many other projects have been undertaken by the SEEDS Equity Office, with indications for the next steps in Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 and 2024.
