Description:

Revised Certification of the Non-Ad Valorem Solid Waste Assessment to allow the County to certify a up to date reflection of the Solid Waste Assessment.

Prior Board Motions:

July 11, 2023, the Board adopted the Resolution and authorized staff to notice the public of the September 12, 2023, Public Hearing to set the rates for the Solid Waste Non-Ad Valorem Assessment and authorized provision of the notice to affected property owners on the Notice of Proposed Taxes (TRIM) (Item #23-00372)

On September 12, 2023, the Board adopted the Solid Waste Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Final Rate Resolution for Fiscal Year 2022-23 (Item #23-00544)

Fiscal Note:

The fiscal impact of the recertification of the Non-Ad Valorem Roll is a decrease of \$1,633.90. The original certification was \$12,739,572.56 and the revised certification is \$12,737,938.66.

Background:

On September 12, 2023, the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners approved the Final Rate Resolution for Solid Waste Assessments and authorized the Manager to certify the non-ad valorem assessment roll and transmit it to the Tax Collector. The Revised Certification of Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll allows the County to certify a more up-to-date reflection of the solid waste assessment prior to finalization of the tax roll.
