World Masters Athletics



- Worldwide governing body for Masters Athletics
- Est. 1975 in Sweden with current registered headquarters in Monaco
- Masters = five-year age group increments, starting with 35+
- Athletics includes track & field, race walking, cross country and road running





- WMACi established in 2004
- Conducted every odd numbered years
- Never held in the United States of America
- 2023 hosted by Torun, Poland with 4,143 athletes representing 89 nations







- ACSEC Pre-opening Indoor Track Series
- USATF Masters Committee / Gainesville Sports Commission site visit
- Spokane, Washington withdrew their bid for 2025
- WMA reopened the bid process with a May 31, 2023 deadline







- 8 Days of Competition
- 4,000+ athletes
- 10,000+ total visitors (athletes, guests, spectators, officials)

WMACi25 Facility Requirements

Main Venue

- ✓ One Indoor track, 6 lane oval, synthetic track surface, raised banks
- ✓ with 8-10 lane 60m straight for spring and hurdling, long jump, high jump, triple jump, pole vault, weight throw
- ✓ Meeting rooms and support facilities
- ✓ Warm-up facilities

Outdoor Throwing Facilities

- Discus
- Hammer
- Javelin

Non-Stadia Events

- ✓ Paved surface for Road Race Walking, Half Marathon, 10km Road Race
- Cross Country 6km and 8km courses on grass or dirt surfaces suitable for older adults
- Support facilities and infrastructure





WMACi25 Required Deliverables

- Over 60 specific deliverables including:
 - World Masters Athletics Fees

• Administration: LOC, corporate fees, volunteers, insurance,

accounting, professional services...

Competition: Staff, officials, timing, equipment, supplies,

facilities, awards, publications, medical, security,

anti-doping...

center, uniforms, credentials, personnel,

hospitality...

Marketing: Branding, publications, advertising, promotions,

videography, photography, livestream, athlete

village, merchandise, personnel...


