**Description:**

The Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) has updated their MOA for equipment and is requiring the updated document be signed. This MOA is for a generator owned by FDEM but is maintained locally in and by Alachua County. The updated MOA outlines the maintenance requirements and associated documentation of maintenance activities performed by Alachua County.

The County has maintained the generator within its existing Emergency Management operating budget since the original agreement on July 14, 2020.

**Background:**

In 2020, the FDEM allocated a generator to each county. Each county that took a generator from FDEM entered into a Memorandum of Agreement. These generators are able to be used locally by the county to which they are assigned but must also be ready to deploy in the event FDEM needs them for an incident happening elsewhere in the state.
