## Description:

Piggyback Agreement from UF with multiple vendors (B&D Electrical, Craft Electric, Del Sol Electric, Gibson Electric, Preston Link, and Southern Atlantic Electric) for on-call electrical services, not to exceed (NTE) \$200,000 per occurrence, up to \$1,000,000.00 annually.

## **Background:**

B&D Electric, Craft Electric, Del Sol Electric, Gibson Electric, Preston Link, and Southern Atlantic Electric are companies that provide on-call electrical services to various clients. By piggybacking on a UF agreement, Alachua County can take advantage of the pre-negotiated pricing and terms that have

already been agreed upon between the University of Florida and these companies. This saves time and resources for both parties, as negotiating a separate contract would be time-consuming and potentially costly.

Executing the addendum agreements will allow Alachua County to receive high-quality electrical services from multiple vendors who have a proven track record of providing reliable and efficient services. This would ensure that Alachua County's buildings and facilities are maintained in optimal condition, which would help to promote a safe and healthy environment for its residents.

This purchase is exempt from the County's competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 22.3-302(12) of the Alachua County Procurement Code, Procurement of Supplies or Services under Contract with federal, state, or municipal governments or any other governmental agency or political subdivision provided the vendor extends the same terms and conditions of the Contract to the County.
