Background:

In 1984, the Board of County Commissioners established the Environmental Advisory Committee to assist and advise the Board of County Commissioners and the Alachua County Environmental Protection Department on environmental issues. The Committee is comprised of 11 members and one alternate serving three-year terms. There are currently three vacancies in the Committee and two additional terms ending June 30, 2023. By selecting four citizens for full terms and an alternate, this will result in providing an appropriate variation of experience, knowledge, and tenures of committee members.
