Prior Board Actions

- August 25, 2020: Approve the Displacement of Commercial Haulers.
- July 13, 2021: Authorize staff to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for an exclusive franchise for the collection of residential and commercial solid waste.
- December 13, 2022: Approved Scope of Work for the Request for Proposals.
- April 11, 2023: Approved ranking of RFP 24-26, GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC received the highest score



Highlights

Term: 10 years with two 5 years renewal options

Implementation:

- Phase 1 : Begins October 1, 2023
 - Commercial
 - Multi-Family Residential Complexes
 - Residential Subscription
- Phase 2 : Begins October 1, 2026
 - Curbside Residential



Staff Recommendation

1. Select GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC as the top rank proposal received in response to Request for Proposal (RFP) 24-26 Annual Collection Services of Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials; and
2. Approve the contract for Exclusive Franchise for the Collection of Residential and Commercial Solid Waste between Alachua County and GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC and authorize the Chair to execute same on behalf of the County.
