## Description:

First Amendment to Agreement to #12029, Annual Temporary Personnel Services. The First Amendment consists of the following:

1. Amend the Agreement to recognize and accept the re-designation from Career Center, Inc. d/b/a Tempforce to Career Center, Inc. d/b/a Spherion effective January 31, 2022

2. Amend the Agreement to update and clarify payment language as it pertains to the application of the Alachua County Government Minimum Wage.

3. Amend the Agreement to update Paragraph 11 of the Agreement, Laws and Regulations, by the inclusion of language pertaining the County's Covid-19 protocols

Approve First Amendment to Contract #12029, Annual Temporary Personnel Services to Career Center, Inc. f/k/a Temp Force now d/b/a Spherion, and authorize the Chair to execute same on behalf of the County.

#### Background:

At various times County Departments have a need to employee temporary personnel services due to

fluctuation of workloads and employee turnover.

Procurement solicited proposals from vendors that provide temporary personnel services through Request for Proposal (RFP) 22-21.

RFP 22- 21 resulted in Contract #12029, approved by the Board on August 24, 2021, with a term from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022 and a clause that allows for two additional 2-year periods, if agreed upon by both the vendor and the County. The vendor, Career Center, Inc. doing business as Temp Force, recently advised the County of a new naming for the business entity- now to be known as Spherion. This First Amendment clarifies the naming change and updates existing paragraphs of the Agreement.
