The Path to Stability program allows for Family Promise to helps Alachua County families living at or below 150% Federal Poverty Level escape the cycle of poverty through educational opportunities. Education plays a vital role in providing individuals with knowledge, skills, and qualifications needed to secure better job opportunities. Higher levels of education often lead to higher income potential and better career prospects. Thus, education is a powerful tool for breaking the cycle of poverty. It equips individuals with the skills and knowledge necessary to improve their economic situation, thereby reducing poverty rates.

Participants in the program will have access to different educational opportunities from certifications to tuition assistance for rapid education programs through Santa Fe College. Education enhances employability and income potential, thereby contributing to financial stability. Well-educated individuals are more likely to secure higher-paying jobs and achieve financial security. Financial stability provides families with a sense of security and enables them to meet their basic needs, such as food, shelter, and healthcare. It improves their overall standard of living and quality of life.

Family Promise of Gainesville is currently the only Rapid Rehousing provider for households with children residing in Alachua County. Family Promise of Gainesville has been serving families low income, homeless and at-risk families with children since 1998. Family Promise maintains one of the highest success rates in the nation. In 2022, 95% of all families remained housed for at least one year after exiting Family Promise programs. We utilize tailored strength-based support services and collaborative case management meetings to help families reach housing stability.

However, due to inflation and the higher cost of living families need to be able to increase their income in order to maintain stable housing. By combining our Rapid Rehousing and Path to Stability Program families can receive assistance with their rent and utilities while pursuing a career certification or rapid credential program. This will increase their probability of maintaining financial and housing stability once they have completed our Rapid Rehousing Program.
