Description:

Increase interfund Loan for fund 023 - LSF 988 grant from \$100,000 to \$400,000. On June 20, 2023 an interfund loan was authorized by memo for the new grant cycle in the amount of \$100,000. The need to increase the amount of the loan is due to the transition from cost reimbursement to a fee-based methodology and because of the large award amount. This interfund loan will be repaid at the end of the grant cycle with close out.

Background:

The Alachua County Crisis Center is a member of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline Network and is one of 12 centers in Florida working on the implementation of the 988 National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. Lutheran Services of Florida is providing initial implementation funding through an appropriation from the Department of Children and Families (DCF). Between the local hotline number and 988, the Center answers over 45,000 calls annually.
