Background:

The proposed changes to the Fire Rescue Special Event Ordinance are as follows:

- 1. Add additional Levels of events. Originally there were three with the smallest being more than 1000. The new levels are 1 (up to 500), 2 (501 to 1000), 3 (1001 to 2000), 4 (2001 to 10,000), and 5 (over 10,000).
- 2. The Fire Rescue Chief can accept tardy applications. Was previously the County Manager only.
- 3. The Fire Rescue Chief can exempt events. Was previously the County Manager only.
- 4. Level 1 events requirements can be waived or reduced by the Fire Chief or Designee if the event does not pose a significant fire or life safety threat.
- 5. The Fire Rescue Chief may approve the Special Event Emergency Management Services (EMS) Plan. Was previously the County Manager.
- 6. All other changes are updated wording and punctuation.
