Description:

The County has received a grant from FDOT for intersection safety modifications at CR 231 and NW 156th Avenue.

Background:

In May 2019, the Public Works Department completed a safety study for the intersection of CR 231 and NW 156th Avenue and determined that the installation of an intersection conflict warning system (ICWS) could help reduce the number of crashes occurring at the intersection.

In November 2019, Public Works completed and submitted to FDOT a Highway Safety Improvement Program grant application to fund the design and construction of the ICWS.

In the fall of 2023, Public Works staff was notified that grant funding had been approved and would become available in early 2024.

FDOT is providing full project funding for the project including reimbursement of staff time. FDOT we require the County to deliver the projects via LAP Agreements which require a resolution to authorize execution of the agreement. The resolution also recognizes unanticipated revenue, approves budge amendment, and authorizes the County Manager, Public Works Director, or County Engineer to execute any subsequent Agreements or Supplemental Agreements related to the project.
