- Wont fully solve gap for patients with Intellectual Disabilities
- This is a gap that needs to be presented to BoCC
- Lindsey suggested inviting Chair for Community Dentistry Program of UF, Dr. Daniel McNeil, to speak with HCAB

5.2 Update on Community Health Assessment (CHA)

- Knowli has been hired for data collection.
- CHA will be finalized next year

5.3 CHW Program Update

- Met with Pastor Duncan, he is getting more agencies to partner with CHW
- Trying to better market program to agencies
- Admis is meeting with supervisors and gathering data
- Suggested that the CHW admin provide suggestions for how to spend \$5,000 communication budget and present at next HCAB meeting
- Concerns voiced about financial and operational controls involving Pastor Duncan
- Erica spoke on the discussions and concerns; more agencies will be recruited, and the concerns shaken out before presenting.
 Further conversations with CHW staff will be had and duties more clearly outlined.
