I guess my rationale is while the museum building remains the property of the town, we lease to the Thrasher Warehouse Board to display their local, historic artifacts. The Thrasher Warehouse Board is made up of local citizens and one Town Commissioner, per the lease agreement. It remains open to the public but donations from visitors are encouraged to assist TWB with operational costs. This arrangement looks and feels different than the Town's other WSPP uses – town owned and maintained parks, ballfields, etc. Why I thought the proposed expense would be a better fit for infrastructure.
