1st Amendment to Agreement 13862 Between Alachua County and GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC

Description:

Amending the exclusive collection agreement for residential and commercial solid waste to correct the commencement date for subscription services, clarify which governmental entities are included in the agreement, include a method to compensate the contractor for dwelling units added to the residential collection program mid-year, clarify what is included in gross billings for the purpose of calculating the franchise fee, and to allow for the contractor to use actual disposal tonnages when available in their invoices to commercial customers.

Recommended Action:

Approve the 1st Amendment to Agreement 13862 between Alachua County and GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC and authorize the Chair to sign the amendment.

Following the procurement of RFP 24-26, the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners entered into Agreement 13862 between Alachua County and GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC. This agreement is an exclusive waste collection agreement for residential and commercial properties in the unincorporated portion of Alachua County.
