I along with two other faculty members in Maddie's Shelter Medicine Program envisioned, funded, and launched the Online Graduate Program in Shelter Medicine in 2012. Graduate students can acquire a Certificate in Shelter Medicine by completing 15 units of coursework or a Master's in Veterinary Science with a Concentration in Shelter

Medicine by completing 30 units of core and elective courses. After attracting an international audience of students and developing a sustainable business model, the program was transferred in 2017 to the College of Medicine's online education unit where it is supported by a fulltime staff of instructional designers and student support services and continues to grow.
