Background:

Public Works has a project to replace existing stormwater pump piping that is within the Heatherwood subdivision. A portion of the project lies along the boundary of platted drainage easement in Heatherwood and the adjacent State-owned property located at 5915 NW 39th Avenue, Gainesville. The additional drainage and access easements from the State is being requested to improve access to construct the replacement piping and maintain the ditch in the Heatherwood easement. The property where the easements are being requested is utilized by ResCare Residential Services under the oversite of the State of Florida Agency for Persons with Disabilities. Both of these entities have provided letters to the County consenting to the State for the easements being granted. In addition to these letters and a sketch and legal description, an adopted resolution by the Board is all that is required to be submitted with a completed application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection – Division of State Lands to have the easements granted. Once granted, a separate item will come before the Board to accept the easements.
