August 28, 2023, passed a Resolution Declaring Gun Violence a Public Health Crisis At the Joint City/County Meeting of January 2024, the Board passed a motion asking staff to identify current steps and stakeholders at the City and County; identify activities related to the local gun violence crisis and return within 60-90 days with a report; include the "10 Essential Activities We Can Take Now to Reduce Gun Violence" and return within 60-90 days with a report on immediate, short-term, and long-term recommendations that could serve as a draft plan for consideration by both Commissions.
