Background:

Addressing Housing is a Top Priority in the City's Strategic Plan and Alachua County has prioritized addressing the Housing Gap as a Guiding Principle in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Strategic Guide. Both the City's Department of Housing & Community Development and Alachua County Community Support Services Department have pivotal roles in the community's effort to achieve its mandate in this area.

The Alachua County Support Services Department and City of Gainesville Department of Housing & Community Development have met monthly to discuss strategies to collectively deal with the affordable housing issues that face our community. To date, the City/County Housing staff have met twelve times and have discussed a series of topics such as Affordable Housing Initiatives, Joint County and City Affordable Housing Advisory Committee collaboration, Local Housing Assistance Plans, and funding sources.
