Conveyance of Public Utility Easement to City of Alachua for Fire Station 21

Description:

The City of Alachua (the "City") requires a Public Utility Easement in connection with the provision of utility services for proposed new Fire Station # 21.

Recommended Action:

Adopt a Resolution approving the conveyance of a Public Utility Easement to the City and authorize the Chair to sign the Easement, Resolution and any other documents approved by the County Attorney that are necessary to complete the conveyance.

Background:

The Alachua County Fire Rescue Department is in the process of relocating Fire Rescue Station # 21 in the City of Alachua. On August 4, 2022 the County acquired a two acre parcel located at 16121 NW 173rd Street, Alachua, FL 32615 for the new Fire Rescue Station # 21. The property abuts the Easterly right-of-way line of CR 235-A and is within the city limits of Alachua. The City will provide utility services to the site.

As a part of the site plan approval process, the City's Development Order requires a 10' by 10' Public Utility Easement adjacent to the Easterly right-of-way line of CR 235-A. The proposed Public Utility Easement location will not impact the development of the site for Fire Rescue Station # 21.
