Consider the applications for one Natural Resource Professional vacancy on the Land Conservation Board.

The Land Conservation Board was established on July 25, 2000 through Ordinance 00-13 and amended through Resolution 22-066 adopted June 28, 2022

**Background:**

Both applicants originally applied to a term ending 9/30/2027, which is why the term dates on their applications differ from the current opening. Another individual was selected for the vacancy they originally applied for, but both applicants wished to continue being considered for future vacancies on the Land Conservation Board. They both agreed to have their applications resubmitted for the current term ending in 9/30/2026.

The Land Conservation Board was created by the Board of County Commissioners in 2000. The eleven citizen (plus one alternate) Land Conservation Board recommends environmentally significant properties to the Board of County Commissioners for inclusion on the Alachua County Forever Acquisition List and makes recommendations on stewardship issues.
