To acquire, improve, and manage environmentally significant lands that protect water resources, wildlife habitats and natural areas suitable for resource-based recreation.

Nominated Property Evaluations in FY 2023


- 18 property nominations reviewed by LCB

- 3 additional projects under contract as of 9/30/23









Lake Santa Fe – Brooks












Santa Fe River - Matthews











Santa Fe River - Bell











Santa Fe River – Waldo Tree Farm






