Description:

A request by Clay Sweger, agent, for Alachua County, owner, for a special use permit to allow a Fire/Rescue Facility on approximately 5 acres in the Rural Agricultural land use designation (one dwelling unit per 5 acres) with an 'A' (Agricultural) district located at 12264 South US Highway 441 on Parcel 16392-000-000.

Staff recommends that the Board adopt Resolution Z-23-04 approving the requested special use permit.

If the special use permit is granted, the Fire Assessment (Fund 011) will reimburse the WSPP Half Cent Sales Tax (Fund 021) for utilization of the acreage needed for the Fire Station, approximately \$26,770.

Background:

Alachua county Fire Rescue is requesting a special use permit to be able to place a fire/rescue facility on approximately 5 acres located on US 441 South. This facility will be used to provide service for the surrounding area including the City of Micanopy. Alachua County entered into an interlocal agreement with the City of Micanopy to begin providing emergency services for the municipality beginning October 1, 2023.
