I. BACKGROUND

This amendment pertains to **connecttrex corp** Service Order designated “**Monitor – Pretrial Batch Import Integration**”, dated 2-12-2024, regarding the specification and delivery of an electronic data interchange between the **SmartCop** jail management system and the **connecttrex corp Monitor Enterprise** application suite. A copy of the Service Order is attached and made part of this agreement.

II. PURPOSE

This Service Order establishes a data interchange that streamlines the operations of the Alachua County Pretrial division: reducing manual data duplication, increasing data accuracy and providing significant time savings.

All other terms and conditions of the above referenced agreement shall remain the same.

Overview

ACCS currently processes/inputs in all Defendant related information manually in **Monitor**. This includes the client’s name, demographics, address, employment, phone, and case/charge information.

Utilizing a Batch On-Demand-Import (ODI), the Pretrial staff will save time and reduce redundant data entry steps and mistakes.

This will allow the staff to focus on the defendant interview, assessment and court report.

Business Rules

- On-Demand Batch Import (**ODI**) will cover 4 possible scenarios:
 - Defendant does not exist in **Monitor**: Create new body, Event, and case information.
 - Defendant exists in **Monitor** from previous Interviews: Create new Event & case information.
 - Defendant exists in **Monitor** with an OPEN Event. Create new case Information.
 - Defendant exists in **Monitor** with and OPEN Event and case information exists: Do nothing.
- **ODI** Matching logic will follow these Rules:
 - **IF** SSN (social security number) match exists, **THEN** Import utilizing one of 4 scenarios
 - **ELSE** match on ‘Last name’, ‘First name’ and ‘Date of Birth’
 - **ELSE** create new body/defendant record in **Monitor** Enterprise.
- **ODI** will include a new Batch ‘Import’ screen as well as an audit log.
- **ODI** audit Log will have a date range (default to “today”) that will display previously imported defendants and the users that completed the import with date and time and case number imported

STATEMENT OF WORK – SERVICE ORDER

Data Flow(s)

1. Users will navigate to the new Batch-Import form in **Monitor** Enterprise.
2. The Roster will auto populate with defendants booked in **SmartCop** in the last 72 hours utilizing an ODBC connection string with username/password supplied by ACCS.
3. The user can select one, some, or all defendants and click the ‘Import’ button. This will import into **Monitor** and follow one of the 4 use-case scenarios outlined in the “business rules” section for each of the defendants selected.
4. Imported defendant records will become unelectable after Import and be indicated with a checkmark under the ‘imported’ column display to indicate and confirm to the user that the import was successful for the selected defendants.


