Description:

Addendum Agreement with World Sports Turf & Marketing, LLC to rebuild Soccer Fields 2 & 3 at the County owned Rotary Park in Jonesville, in the amount of \$303,030.00, for Parks and Open Space. This Addendum is based on the Hillsborough County Agreement (RFQ/ITB (Request for Quote/Invitation to Bid) No. 24197.

Recommended Action:

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Addendum Agreement with World Sports Turf & Marketing, LLC to rebuild Soccer Fields 2 & 3 at the County owned Rotary Park in Jonesville, in the amount of \$303,030.00.

Prior Board Motions:

February 7, 2023, the Board adopted the Parks & Open Space Master Plan that calls for, among other things, bringing existing parks up to acceptable level of service standards.

Fiscal Note:

There are sufficient funds to cover the contract amount of \$303,030.00.

Background:

Sports fields require periodic rebuilding for turf health, performance, and proper drainage. The work of this contract will include eradicating existing grass & weeds, removing irrigation heads, rototilling existing material 4-6" deep, laser leveling, reinstalling irrigation heads, fertilizing, and resodding using big rolls of Bermuda Grass sod. Each field is 2.7 acres for a total area of 5.4 acres.

The addendum agreement is based on the Hillsborough County Agreement (RFQ/ITB (Request for

Quote/Invitation to Bid) No. 24197.

This purchase is exempt from the County's competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 22.3-302 (12) of the Alachua County Procurement Code, Procurement of Supplies or Services under Contract with federal, state, or municipal governments or any other governmental agency or political subdivision provided the vendor extends the same terms and conditions of the Contract to the County; however, since the dollar amount of the purchase exceeds the purchasing authority of the Procurement Manager, this is being submitted for Board consideration and approval.
