Background:

Pursuant to Resolution 22-105, the Infrastructure Surtax Oversight Board (ISOB) shall consist of 7 voting members and three alternate members. Alachua County is entitled to appoint 4 voting members and one alternate member. The other 3 voting member seats and two alternate member seats are appointed by the municipalities, with the City of Gainesville being responsible to appoint two voting members and one alternate, and the other eight municipalities being responsible to jointly recommend the appointment of one voting member and one alternate member to the BoCC for approval. This agenda item pertains to the recommendation of the eight small municipalities' to appoint one voting member and one alternate member. Both applicants are qualified for appointment as small city representatives. Both applications were shared with the small cities for review prior to placing on today's agenda, but the small cities have not provided a recommendation as to which should be appointed to the voting member seat and which should be appointed to the alternate member seat.

The ISOB is responsible to review surtax expenditures to ensure eligibility per the County ordinance and state law.
