

RESOLUTION 24-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there exists a State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Springs Protection Program Grant Agreement between Alachua County and the FDEP, to provide funding to reimburse a portion of the costs associated with the conservation easement purchase of the High Springs – Shires property.

WHEREAS, Alachua County shall receive unanticipated revenue in 50% of the 1 Cent Surtax WSPF Fund (Fund 140) in the amount of \$190,575, and

WHEREAS, the \$190,575 shall be used to reimburse a portion of the cost of the conservation easement acquisition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the fiscal year 2024 budget for the 50% of the 1 Cent Surtax WSPF Fund (Fund 140) is hereby amended as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
2. By adoption of this resolution and the attached budget amendment, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, hereby appropriates and permits the expenditure of the funds described therein.
3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
