I have a vested interest in the healthcare of this community, including East Gainesville and Alachua County as a whole. I lost my father, grandfather, and uncle to heart disease in their 50's. My son is gifted and in the magnet at Howard Bishop; my daughter is mild on the spectrum and in private school on a state scholarship, and my brother- a veteran- experiences a significant mental health condition and has experienced homelessness in the past. I have a good understanding of mental health, addiction, trauma, the social determinants of health, healthcare disparities, racism, discrimination, stigma, and genetics. I believe in the importance of diversity and inclusion and the right to basic and emergency healthcare and housing. We have an amazing healthcare community in Gainesville, but we still have gaps in care and work to do. I am passionate but a rule follower and work well on a team.
