RESOLUTION 24-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there exists a State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Springs Protection Program Grant Agreement between Alachua County and the FDEP, to provide funding to reimburse a portion of the costs associated with the conservation easement purchase of the High Springs – Shires property.

WHEREAS, Alachua County shall receive unanticipated revenue in 50% of the 1
Cent Surtax WSPP Fund (Fund 140) in the amount of \$190,575, and

WHEREAS, the \$190,575 shall be used to reimburse a portion of the cost of the conservation easement acquisition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- 1. That the fiscal year 2024 budget for the 50% of the 1 Cent Surtax WSPP Fund (Fund 140) is hereby amended as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
- 2. By adoption of this resolution and the attached budget amendment, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, hereby appropriates and permits the expenditure of the funds described therein.
- 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
