

****UPCOMING** ALACHUA COUNTY SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) ACTION PLAN**

BACKGROUND & PROJECT PURPOSE—In early 2023, the U.S. Department of Transportation awarded Alachua County \$262,500 for implementing the "Alachua County Safe Streets and Roads for All Action Plan." The purpose of the Alachua County Safe Streets and Roads for All Action Plan ('Action Plan') is to better understand the underlying and systemic causes of severe and fatal crashes and address them through an equity-focused action plan – including prioritized projects, policies, and programs – and subsequent capital projects.
