The Florida Coalition Against Sexual Violence (FCASV) has received additional grant funding from the Department of Health and is contracting with Rape Crisis Centers to provide services to victims of sexual assault. This agreement, effective 12/1/23 through 6/30/25, provides \$63,786.00 of funding for the period ending 6/30/24. The agreement also includes a provision regarding Patents, Copyrights, Royalties, and Ownership of Property which conflicts with the Board adopted policy regarding Intellectual Property (Page 28, Section S.)

The Alachua County Victim Services Rape Crisis Center is funded in part through the General Fund and grant awards from both the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) administered by the Florida Office of Attorney General and from the Florida Coalition Against Sexual Violence (FCASV). The VOCA funding award for FY 23/24 was reduced by approximately \$70,000.00. The FCASV worked with the Department of Health to acquire additional funding through the Family Violence Prevention and
