Second Amendment 12104 with Chris Torrence Electric & Utility Inc. for BID 23-994 Intersection Improvements at CR 235 and Newberry Lane for a total fiscal impact of \$205,937.70, for Public Works. The Second Amendment updates required Federal language FHWA-1273.

Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Second Amendment to Agreement with Chris Torrence Electric & Utility Inc. for Intersection Improvements at CR 235 and Newberry Lane, No. 12104 for a total fiscal impact of \$205,937.70.

Prior Board Motions:

October 24, 2023, Board approved First Amendment 12104 with Chris Torrence Electric & Utility Inc. for BID 23-994 Intersection Improvements at CR 235 and Newberry Lane for a total fiscal impact of \$205,937.70. Item 23-00679.

July 11, 2023, Board approved the Solicitation Award and Contract 12104 for BID 23-994 Intersection Improvements at CR 235 and Newberry Lane – Project 9197909 – LAP - Rebid, to Chris Torrence Electric & Utility Inc., for a total fiscal impact of \$205,937.70, for Public Works, also authorize the Chair to sign the contract and approve budget amendment moving funds from two other projects to supplement the LAP funding for this project. Item 23-00223.

August 27, 2019, Board approved Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) LAP Agreement for oversight of the design of the intersection at Newberry Lane and CR 235. Item 19-0001.

September 16, 2021/October 26, 2021, Board approved FDOT LAP Agreement for construction and CEI project management for intersection improvements at Newberry Lane and CR 235. Item 21-0897.

Fiscal Note:

The second amendment does not change the funding that was previously approved.

Approval of the first amendment has no additional fiscal impact over the \$205,937.70 approved with

the original contract from the following Funds/Accounts: FDOT Grants Fund/329.79.7910.541.63.01, Transportation Trust Fund/341.79.7910.541.63.01 and 5-Cent Local Option Gas Tax Fund/350.79.7910.541.63.01.

The CR 235 at Newberry Lane project is an intersection safety improvement by adding additional flashing beacons and warning signs to create an intersection conflict warning system.
