NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, will consider the adoption of an ordinance of its meeting to be held on June 11, 2024, at 5:00p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. The hearing will be held at the Alachua County Administration Building, 12 SE 1st Street, Second Floor, Jack Durran Auditorium, Gainesville, Florida 32601. Said ordinance being titled:  
AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 221(A) OF THE ALACHUA COUNTY HOME RULE CHARTER, PROVIDING FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO BE ELECTED ON A COUNTYWIDE BASIS; PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF ADOPTION OF A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTY CHARTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, IF APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF ELECTORS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF ALACHUA COUNTY AND CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR LIBERAL CONSTRUCTION AND INTERPRETATION; AND ALLOWING FOR MODIFICATION OF THE LANGUAGE OF THE ORDINANCE DUE TO CONSIDERATIONS ARISING AT A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

All interested persons may attend and provide public comment. Masks for vulnerable citizens are strongly recommended.

Meetings will be broadcast over Cox Channel 12 and the County's Video on Demand website. The public may submit written comments and photographic documents to the Board through email ([boc@alachuacounty.us](mailto:boc@alachuacounty.us)) before the meeting.
