Description:

The Small Grant Initiative (SGI) will award one-time funding for capacity building and infrastructure in a total amount of \$140,000.000, with individual awards not to exceed (NTE) \$15,000.00

Recommended Action:

Approve Request for Application (RFA) 25-416-PM with integrated application and delegate authority to the County Manager to appoint Grant Review Committee members.

Prior Board Motions:

On February 23, 2021 the BoCC approved using unexpended CAPP funds for one-time awards.

Fiscal Note:

Strategic Guide:

Social and Economic Opportunity

Background:

Community Agency Partnership Program (CAPP) currently awards 3-year funding to successful applicants that provide programming in specific categories to benefit Alachua County residents at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level. For a variety of reasons, the annual budgeted amount is often not fully expended. The intent of this RFA is to award one-time grants for capacity building and infrastructure to emerging businesses using the unexpended dollars; ongoing programming is not allowed. The anticipated number of awards is 9-10.
