#### **RESOLUTION 24-**

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONVEYING A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 337 AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROAD 26 IN THE CITY OF NEWBERRY, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE CONVEYANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") proposes to construct one-way pairs to make State Road 26 run one-way east bound and to make NW 1st Avenue run one-way westbound in Alachua County, Florida (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, in order to construct the project, FDOT requires that the County convey its interest in certain right-of-way, as described in **Exhibit "A"**, to FDOT (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, FDOT has made application to the County requesting that the County execute and deliver to FDOT a County Deed in favor of FDOT over the Property, which comprises a portion of CR337 at its intersection with State Road 26; and

WHEREAS, a copy of FDOT's application is attached hereto as Exhibit B; and
WHEREAS, the cost of all construction will be undertaken solely by FDOT in
connection with the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, §125.38 Florida Statutes authorizes the County to convey its interests in real property to another governmental entity, such as FDOT, without competition or advertisement; and

**WHEREAS**, §335.0415(3), Florida Statutes, provides for the transfer of public roads between jurisdictions, including from a county to FDOT: and

WHEREAS, said application having been duly considered, the Board of County Commissions of Alachua County, Florida ("Board") make the following findings: (i) the

property interest requested by FDOT are not needed for County purposes; (ii) FDOT is an agency of the state of Florida and is, therefore, qualified to request conveyances of County property pursuant to §125.38, Florida Statutes; and (iii) FDOT requires the property interest for a public purpose and such purpose is in the community interest and welfare; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §125.38 and §335.0415(3), Florida Statutes, the County shall transfer ownership and maintenance responsibility for the Property to the FDOT; and

WHEREAS, upon said transfer of ownership to the FDOT, the Property will cease to be part of the County Road System and shall become part of the State Highway System as defined in §334.03(24), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board finds that it is the County's best interest to execute and deliver a county deed the FDOT to transfer ownership and maintenance responsibilities of the Property to the FDOT.

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA;

- **1.** The Board finds, determines, and declares that the recitals in the preamble are true and correct, and hereby incorporates them by reference.
- 2. The Board authorizes and directs the conveyance of the Property to FDOT by the County Deed attached hereto as **Exhibit C** to the FDOT, for the nominal sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).
- 2. The Board authorizes and directs the Chair to execute the County Deed, and any other documents approved by the County Attorney needed to complete this conveyance.

3. This resolution shall take effect	ct immediately upon its adoption.
