#### **Fiscal Note:**

Project is funded in 5-Cent Local Option Gas Tax Fund in account: 350.79.7910.541.63.01, Project: 9197902-FY19-2 - Bike/Pedestrian Projects, Fiscal Year 2019, Kincaid Loop Trail with estimated total project budget of \$3,078,551. With approval of budget amendment, there should be funds for this contract.

#### **Background:**

This solicitation is to design and permit approximately 3.34 miles of 10 foot wide multi-use path, and related stormwater improvements, on the following three corridors, also known as Kincaid Loop:

- SE 15th Street from northern Boulware Springs entrance to SE 41st Avenue (Payne's Prairie entrance)
- SE 41st Avenue from SE 15th Street (Payne's Prairie entrance) to SE 27th Street
- SE 27th Street from SE 41st Avenue to SE Hawthorne Road

An initial public involvement meeting was held on February 3, 2024. During that meeting the final location of the trail was discussed. Participants seemed to prefer the west side of SE 15th Street, most preferred the south side of SW 41st Avenue, and no consensus was reached on SE 27th Street. The design team has been tasked with resolving the final routing along SE 27th Street and conducting additional public involvement as decisions are made.

RFP 23-414 Architecture and Engineering Services for the Kincaid Loop Trail was released May 10, 2023. The deadline for receipt of RFP 23-414 Architecture and Engineering Services for the Kincaid Loop Trail was July 5, 2023; four (4) vendors responded.
