**Description:**

Consider the eight (8) applications for five citizen-at-large vacancies and one alternate vacancy in the Environmental Protection Advisory Committee (EPAC).

**Recommended Action:**

Appoint six (6) citizens to three (3) full term citizen-at-large positions ending June 30, 2027, one (1) citizen-at-large stub term ending June 30, 2026, one (1) citizen-at-large stub term ending June 30, 2025, and one (1) alternate stub term ending on June 30, 2026.

**Background:**

In 1984, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) established EPAC to assist and advise the BOCC and the Alachua County Environmental Protection Department on environmental issues. The Committee is comprised of 11 members and one alternate serving three-year terms. There are currently three (3) vacancies resulting in stub terms and three (3) full terms ending June 30, 2024. Selecting six (6) citizens to fill these positions will result in providing an appropriate variation of experience, knowledge, and tenures of committee members.
