
Purpose (Resolution 2020-68):

- Provide recommendations to Joint Water & Climate Policy Board (JWCPB)
- Assist and advise the County and municipalities on the Climate Action Plan and on innovative climate adaptation and mitigation strategies, policies, and target goals.
- Engage with stakeholders, agencies, non-profits and the community.
- Ensure that neighborhoods and communities that are most impacted or disadvantaged by climate change are taken into account in the development of policy recommendations and the Climate Action Plan.
- Assist in promotion of greater community awareness of climate-related issues and involvement in government climate resiliency initiatives.

FY2024 Goals:

- Maintain and establish relationships with community groups:
 - CCAC members will be point of contact liaisons for collaboration with community groups and interested parties on specific issues
 - Maintain a platform to communicate activities, events, and accomplishments
 - Develop a plan that allows the CCAC to regularly engage with the community

FY2024 Goals:

- Work with staff to interpret greenhouse gas emissions inventories to identify next steps and prioritize sectors for emissions reduction
- Work with staff to interpret vulnerability analysis
- Help coordinate a fall climate summit



FY2024 Goals:

- Help with marketing and community engagement of the Climate Action Plan (CAP)
- Assist with engaging the smaller cities and communities with the development of the CAP







Recommendations and Actions to date:

- Heard presentations on Climate change impacts related to landscaping, tree protection, land conservation, solid waste, energy, flooding and infrastructure, water conservation and water quality, and community engagement
- Provided recommendations on two Ecoloop proposals
- Representation on the GRU Integrated Resource Plan (IRP)
 Stakeholder Advisory Committee
- Continue to provide regular updates to the JWCPB

Accomplishments during first half of FY24:

- Maintained and added contacts with community groups
- Working with staff on draft climate action plan initiatives
- Helping to coordinate fall climate summit
