



#### History

- The plat of Orange Summit of Hawthorne Heights was recorded on October 28, 1925, Plat Book B, Page 15 of the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida with the streets dedicated to the public use forever.
- The dedication was formally accepted by the Board on October 24, 2017 by Resolution 17-124
- On August 15, 2023, the property owner filed an application to vacate a portion of the plat and Rights-of-Way within the plat of Orange Summit of Hawthorne Heights as recorded in Plat Book B Page 15 of the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida
- The applicants are seeking to vacate pursuant to Florida Statute 177.101 and the Alachua County Code of Ordinances Section 402.63-64.

### Orange Summit of Hawthorne Heights Plat Vacation



### Section 177.101 (3), Fla. Stat.,

The governing bodies of the counties of the state may adopt resolutions vacating plats in whole or in part of subdivisions in said counties, returning the property covered by such plats either in whole or in part into acreage. Before such resolution of vacating any plat either in whole or in part shall be entered by the governing body of a county, it must be shown that the persons making application for said vacation own the fee simple title to the whole or that part of the tract covered by the plat sought to be vacated, and it must be further shown that the vacation by the governing body of the county will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision.

### Section 402.64(a) of Alachua County Code,

 Action by Board of County Commissioners Approval of Vacation of Plat

If the Board determines at a Public Hearing that vacating the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision or adjacent properties, it may adopt the appropriate resolution vacating all or a portion of the plat.
