Description:

Alachua County entered into a contract for services with Human Rights Coalition of Alachua County, Inc. signed July 12, 2023. Human Rights Coalition has now merged with Rural Women's Health Project to form a single legal entity under Rural Women's Health Project. Rural Women's Health Project seeks to transfer the contract and its remaining rights and obligations to themselves and consents to the assignment and novation of all rights, title, interests, duties, obligations, responsibilities and liabilities for, in and relate to the agreement.

Background:

Alachua County entered into an agreement with Human Rights Coalition of Alachua County, Inc. on July 12, 2023 in order to provide aid Alachua County in adequately responding to Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act and Executive Order 13166, which require entities receiving federal financial assistance to provide meaningful access to programs and services by eligible persons regardless of race, color, national origin, or English language proficiency. This program was originally funded by American Rescue Act Plan ("COVID Relief") dollars which have been transformed into Revenue Recovery dollars.
