NOVATION AND SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, NO.13857

THIS NOVATION AND SECOND AMENDMENT ("Amendment") is made by and between Alachua County, Florida, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida, (the "County") and HUMAN RIGHTS COALTION OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC, hereinafter referred to as "Assignor" or "HRCAC" and RURAL WOMEN'S HEALTH PROJECT, INC., a Florida not for profit corporation which is authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "Assignee" or "RWHP", (collectively the "Parties").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the County and HRCAC previously entered into an Agreement dated July 12, 2023, identified by No. 13857 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS the County and HRCAC previously entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement, dated September 7, 2023, (the "First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS the County has been informed that the commencing on July 1, 2024, HRCAC will assimilate the HRC programs to RWHP; and

WHEREAS, the County consents to the assignment and novation from Assignor to Assignee of all rights, title, interests, duties, obligations, responsibilities and liabilities for, in and related to the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the novation and agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. <u>Novation</u>. The parties agree that the rights and obligations of HRCAC under and by way of the Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment, between the County and HRCAC are transferred to RWHP as of the effective date of this Amendment.
- B. <u>Amendment</u>. All references to HRCAC in the Agreement, as of the effective date, shall be considered to mean RWHP.
- C. <u>Amendment</u>. Section #11.N, of the Agreement titled "Notice" is amended to reflect the address of RWHP:

RWHP 1108 SW 2ND AVE GAINESVIILE, FL 32601

- D. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Amendment shall be effective on July 1, 2024 ("effective date").
- E. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Unless expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the Parties, including any prior amendments to the Agreement, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the prior amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
