#### Background:

The Office of Victim Services Rape Crisis Center within the Department of Community Support Services provides a wide range of services for victims of crime and sexual assault. Services include counseling, court accompaniment, advocacy, and assistance with a variety of physical, social, and emotional needs. The Amendment 11 with the FCASV provides two sources of funds, the General Revenue (GR) and Trust Fund (TF) accounts. The \$163,715.00 awarded from GR is used to pay Union County office rent and salary and fringe benefits for the Victim Advocate Counselor. The TF funding, \$45,120.00 is used to fund an additional Victim Advocate Counselor.
