First Amendment with INdigital to increase the bandwidth and associated cost for 911 Services.

Description:

First amendment with INdigital to increase provided bandwidth from 10MB to 100MB which results in an annual cost increase of \$2,863.91.

Recommended Action:

Approve the First Amendment with INdigital, Inc.

Prior Board Motions:

The Board approved the Agreement between BoCC and INdigital on April 26,2022 (Item #22-0282)

Fiscal Note:

Beginning October 1, 2024, the INdigital annual cost of service is increasing by \$2,863.91 from \$81,883.21 to \$84,747.12. There are sufficient funds in the Enhanced 911 fund operating budget to cover the increase (126.54.5471.529.41.00 Communication Services).

Strategic Guide:

Public Safety

Background:

The INdigital network is a private, public safety only, network maintained by INdigital. The original agreement with INdigital provided a 10MB network path to deliver 911 traffic to the Combined Communications Center (CCC).

The CCC is transitioning to a hosted (off site) map which will require greater bandwidth. Bandwidth is not sold in increments of ten, therefore, the new bandwidth will be 100MB. A 100MB bandwidth will allow for the map to operate on a secure, redundant, and resilient public safety only network, therefore limiting a disruption of service to CCC.
