Contract Overview

- Contract awarded to Trinity Services Group, Inc. as result of RFP #22-3
- Services commenced October 1, 2022
- Agreement term of 3-year base period plus (2) 1-year option periods
- Staffing commitment of (1) Director & (4) Supervisors
- Incorporates Good Food Purchasing Program



Achievements

- Florida Food Code (F.A.C. 64E-11.002) maintained at highest level of “Satisfactory”
- Florida Model Jail Standards inspections 2023 & 2024 passed with zero Food Services findings
- Florida Correctional Accreditation Commission reaccreditation 2023 passed with zero Food Service findings
- Good Food Purchasing Program – Achieved Two Stars self-certification 2024
- Healthy Options for Staff Dining
- Minimal Inmate Grievances Received – 7 Formal & 66 Informal Requests Since Contract Inception



Contract Staffing

- Staffing has been largest operational challenge
- Hot-Hot-Cold(sack) meal pattern implemented to reduce kitchen hours, limit use of inmate workers and create staffing efficiencies
- Training for all employees on basic and advanced quality assurance standards
 - Live Off-Site Events, Virtual Proctored Events, Self-Paced
 - Mandatory QA Training, Rookies Fast Track, ServSafe Food Handlers certifications, kitchen and safety training



Menu

Menu Created with Good Food Purchasing Goals in Mind

- 2700 calorie Hot-Hot-Cold Heart Healthy Menu
- Plant Based Main Dishes – Shepard’s Pie, Red Chili Stew, Taco Mix, Chili Mac, Vegetarian Patty
- Scratch-made menu items – Breakfast Bars, Meatloaf, Sausage Patty, Burritos
- Whole Grain products
- 100% fruit juice
- Less than or equal to 480mg of sodium per item
- Total of estimated 11 program check marks toward goals, earning 1 point for Nutrition component of Good Food Purchasing Program
- Administer 6 different therapeutic diets to 53 inmates, including 14 Vegetarians



Local Economies (2 pts)

- Use of Cheney Brothers as Level 1 Supplier & working to source alternate compliant ingredients

Environmental Sustainability (3 pts.)

- Use of Cheney Brothers, meatless meal plan & no bottled water on menu

Valued Workforce (3 pts.)

- System to report violations with retaliatory protections & paying above Living Wage

Animal Welfare (2 pts.)

- Vegan menu options

Nutrition (1 pt.)

- Achieved Level 1 compliance based on 11 checked boxes per Registered Dietician's review

Overall Year 1 Compliance 2 Stars (11 pts.)
