If you have taken the Extension Office's Agricultural Entrepreneurial Series, please attach your Farm Plan. (5 bonus points) We respectfully request \$2,686 toward a Berta 26" flail mower (quote attached.) This is a mower implement that attaches to the Grillo walk-behind tractor that we purchased last year with the assistance of SMAACA funds. By using a mower that is powered by the Grillo, we will be maximizing the usefulness of the walk-behind tractor, using it for two vital jobs in the field.

A mower is used in our vegetable production system to chop up crop residue and cover crops, allowing them to be more easily incorporated into the soil. Returning all organic material to the soil is an integral part of our regenerative farming system. Up to this point, we have been using a rotary mower mounted on our 1941 Ford Tractor, which leaves residue only partly chopped up. We previously used heavier tillage equipment, such as a disc harrow, to then incorporate this rough residue. However, since acquiring the Grillo walk-behind tractor with the power harrow implement, we have eliminated the use of the disc harrow, thus greatly reducing tillage. We now till only the top two inches of soil, rather than the previous six to eight inches. This has dramatically improved our soil health, increased the benefits of our farm-made compost, greatly reduced our fuel consumption and reduced our dependence on aging equipment.

A flail mower for our farm would help maximize the effectiveness of the power harrow by chopping crop residues into much smaller particles, depositing them right on top of the beds, which will be much easier to incorporate into the soil with the power harrow.

The benefits of improved soil health due to reduced tillage are hard to quantify, but due to the marked improvement of our crops' health and productivity, we can confidently say it has greatly improved our farm's profitability. The mower would contribute by improving our efficiency in incorporating crop residues and preparing seed beds. In addition, use of the walk-behind tractor reduces our fuel consumption by about half compared to the Ford Tractor. This results in a large reduction in fuel consumption, which saves money, reduces our dependence on non- renewable energy and reduces our

carbon emissions. We currently spend about \$250 a year on fuel for mowing, which would be reduced to \$125 with the Berta Flail Mower.
